








Bridges To Inclusion

Neurodiversity In the Workplace

Is an employment initiative that works holistically to place and support people with Autism into high-level technology based jobs and related fields. The program also works to prepare schools, employers, youth and adults with Autism for employment.





Neurodiversity In the Workplace Social Skills Training

- 40 hours of training developed with the Autism expertise of Dr. Robert Naseef and Dr. Stephen Shore
- > Pilot training project trained 25 adults with Autism
- Used as a basis for training modules that will be used in schools and with employers to train individuals with autism as well as, professionals and managers.



Neurodiversity In the Workplace Preparing Transition Age Youth with Autism for Employment

- > 8-10 trainings to be given across the state in collaboration with the Office of Rehabilitation, the Pennsylvania Department of Education and SAP
- Two pilot trainings have already reached 250 professionals in education and vocational rehabilitation



Neurodiversity In the Workplace SAP High School Summer Academy

Planning and developing curriculum for a pilot project this summer at SAP which will work with 8 high school students on the autism spectrum to do a two week academy at SAP with a focus on learning technical and social skills for employment.



Youth Leadership Abilities Project

"Preparing the youth of today to be leaders for tomorrow"

The project promotes and supports leadership skills and opportunities for youth with intellectual and developmental disabilities in Philadelphia.





Youth Leadership Abilities Project Youth Leadership Forum
