planting instructions

The plants tolerate partial shade and need 4 hours a day of direct sunlight. Will grow to about 3'. Germination may begin as quickly as one week or may take up to six weeks depending on your regional growing zone.

Cover seed paper with just 1/8" of soil and keep moist until established. Keep watering the plants until you see sprouts, then keep watering regularly until the plant is established. Seedlings do not have the strength to survive even a brief drought.

Wildflower blend includes Snapdragon (Annual), Petunia (Annual), Beardtongue (Perennial), Papaver (Annual), Mountain Mint (Perennial), Chamomile (Perennial).
